3. Purpose of data processing

The purpose of data processing is the registration process to organise and hold the ESIWACE2 Second Workshop on Emerging Technologies for Weather and Climate Modelling as a fully virtual event on October 7, 2022.

An additional purpose of the processing is the collection of aggregate participant statistics for reporting to the European Commission and for documentation and dissemination purposes, such as news items about the event.

In order to make the workshop contents more sustainable and to make them available to audiences well beyond the registered participants, the workshop will be recorded with the speakers' permission, and published via the ESIWACE YouTube feed, the ESIWACE web page or similar means.

Workshop participants who do not wish to appear in the recording must leave their camera switched off and their microphone muted. Participants who do not want questions to be published are free to contact the presenters after the training sessions via standard means of communication.

4. Legal basis of data processing

The legal basis of data processing for event organisation is the contract that is concluded with us upon registration (Art. 6 Abs. 1 lit. b GDPR).

If you have consented to this, the legal basis for the collection of participant statistics is precisely this consent (Art. 6 Abs. 1 lit. a GDPR).

The legal basis for processing in these instances is Article 6, para. 1, lit. f GDPR (legitimate interests of the controller).
